Attend Today. Achieve Tomorrow.

Attending school on time, every day provides your child with the opportunities for discovery, exploration, learning and achievement they need to thrive. Children who attend school regularly are more likely to:

- · read at or above grade level.
- read at or above grant
 do well in math,
 build lasting relationships that support their social and emotional well-being, and
 that binh school.

If your child is absent for just two days per month. they end up missing nearly a month of the school year. The more school time a student misses, the more challenging it becomes to catch up.

Use this checklist to be sure your student is ready to attend school on the first day, September 5th, and everyday during the school year.

Make sure your child is up to date on required immunizations and physicals Free school-required vaccines and PIAA required sports physicals are available at any CityLife Health Clinic or City Health Center in Philadelphia. Schedule an appointment at philasd org/vax or by calling 1-877-926-9272.

Know your child's bell & bus schedule
Check the school's website or call the school office for details.

Readjust your child's sleep schedule
As school nears, start setting back your child's bedtime and waking them up earlier (if needed) to make the school transition easier.

Review the School Year Calendar
Visit philasd org/calendar. Take special note of holidays and 3-hour early dismissal days so you can plan ahead.

Update your contact information
Moved? New phone number? Emergency contacts changed? Contact the school and let them know.
Having correct information on file allows school staff to share important updates and contact you
in an emergency.

Register for a Parent and Family Portal account if you don't yet have one It's the best way to directly access information about your child's attendance, grades, test scores, immunization records and more. Register at philasd orgy/piportal.

Check your child's Chromebook
