The high school is comprised of two buildings: a 9th Grade Center with more than 640 students and a 10-12th Grade Center with more than 1,900 students.

Spring-Ford Area High School has been recognized by Newsweek as one of America's Top High Schools and a U.S. News and World Report Best High School in America. In addition, SFAHS has been recognized eight times as an Annual AP District Honor Roll recipient.

SFAHS course offerings include Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, Honors and Academic. A typical Spring-Ford high school student's schedule includes between 6.0 and 6.9 credits per year. Spring-Ford Area School District is located in the western portion of Montgomery County. The district is comprised of the Townships of Limerick and Upper Providence and the Boroughs of Royersford and Spring City. The growing community of approximately 52,000 offers the best of both a small-town atmosphere and proximity to metropolitan attractions. The location offers easy access to the cultural appeal of Philadelphia, as well as the warmth and nurturing feel of suburban America.

The district is approximately 20 miles northwest of Philadelphia, 25 miles south of Reading, and five miles north of Valley Forge National Park. The district has a combined land area of 44.4 square miles, and the 2020 US Census population of the district is 50,990, compared to 47,368 in 2010 and 36,483 in 2000.
